

## Mrs. Rodgers' Sixth Grade Supply List (08-09)

**1 three metal ring notebook** (the lighter, the better – They go home every night.)

**8 dividers** (one for notes, language arts, math, science, social studies, health, spelling, Friday Folder section - put in this order)

**2 separate spiral notebooks** (approximately 70 page count)

**Folders** Two or three two-pocket folders

**Ink pens** (blue or black pens for writing, red pens for grading)

**Pencils** (#2 lead)

**1 metric ruler, 1 protractor, 1 pair of scissors, 1 glue stick**

**Colored Pencils**

**1 to 2 large box/boxes of tissues**

**Notebook paper** (college rule)

**Graph paper**

**3 by 5 notecards** (several packages)

**Music Supplies** One 2-pocket folder and 2 pencils to donate to music class

Please have these supplies as soon as possible at the beginning of the school year.

**Students will need to have these supplies all year.** *I frequently see students run out of notebook paper, pens, pencils, notecards, etc.* If something happens to the ruler, protractor, or scissors, they need to be replaced.

It is also a good idea to have some supplies at home for homework assignments. It saves transporting and possibly losing various supplies.
